Jeju Science Park located in Yeongpyeong-dong, is an industrial complex, where outstanding companies in the fields of information & communication technology and life science, not only creates local jobs, but also contributes to Jeju's growth.

JDC leads the industry and economy of Jeju

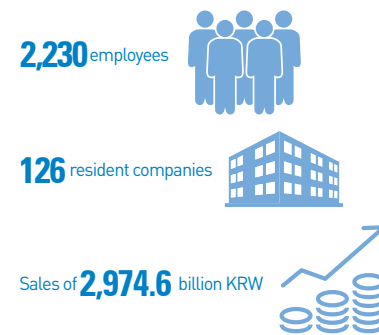
Construction of Jeju Science Park, one of seven major projects of Jeju Free International City, has been successfully completed, which has driven sophistication of the industrial structure in Jeju especially for IT/BT, and the vitalization of local industries.

Upon the opening of Jeju Science Park in 2011, JDC has actively supported the resident companies with its extensive domestic and overseas networks.

So far, 126 companies have moved into Jeju Science Park, including Kakao, EST Soft, Dentium, and BMI Korea. The employees working in the Park number nearly 2,230, and annual sales achieved by those companies amount to 2,974.6 billion KRW.

The Jeju Science Park II, to be completed in 2021, will significantly improve the industrial environment and create more jobs in Jeju.

Public Rental Housing

JDC carried forward a public rental housing supply project to stabilize Jeju people's residence. Focusing on the residents' happiness and convenience the most, it will be a stepping stone for Free International City where its residents are delighted.

Public rental housing blooming happy living space

JDC announced an advance to public housing business in January, 2016, and is now carrying forward supply of public rental housing. First construction of public rental housing will be in Jeju Science Park. The public rental housing will be built in the site of 48,972㎡ in the first Science Park before the first half of 2020, and the residents will move in during the same year. A total of 793 households will move in this 10-year public rental housing, and among them, 402 households consist of young generations such as workers of the industrial complex, newly-married couples and university students, and the rest 391 households are houseless people.

Global Education City

English education city is an international education hub that formed Northeast Asia's best education infra with commercial, residential and public facilities with international schools at the center. This city provides world-class education service, which leads to decrease in studying abroad and reducing its expenditure.

Global Education City with prestigious international schools and sustainable housing solutions

JDC has successfully invited three prestigious private schools, NLCS (UK), BHA (Canada), and SJA (USA) from major English-speaking countries, to help Korean students improve their foreign language skills without leaving Korea. In particular, 92.9% of the first graduates from the schools in 2013 applied to prominent universities with early admission such as Cambridge University in the UK, and thus the Global Education City has saved students the costs of studying overseas by 574.7 billion KRW. In addition, the city has contributed to alleviating educational polarization by operating scholarship systems and English camps, especially targeting the underprivileged in our society.

NLCS Jeju, which opened in September, 2011, is the first school of this English education city and the first foreign campus of NLCS with 169-year tradition. It implements the reputation and sophisticated classes of the UK's most significant private school to students in Jeju. NLCS Jeju follows the curriculum and IB(International Baccalaureate) diploma of its head school in the UK that leads excellent academic performances, guided by teachers selected by the head school.

SJA Jeju, opened in October, 2017, is operated based on the excellent curriculum, educational philosophy and know-how of the head school in the USA with qualified educational programs which was enforced in 1852, so its students can learn the traditional education of the northeast areas of the USA. 'Senior Capstone', which is SIA's own differentiated curriculum, is an intensive course for SIA Jeju's graduating classes, so its seniors can select a topic they are interested in, research about it, and seek for solutions.

Kindergarteners and 1st to 5th graders in elementary school are coeducational, 6th graders in middle school to high school students are female. There is 'International Baccalaurete' for all the kindergarteners and students. This school especially operates 'IB diploma program', which is an internationally-certified educational course to teach English, economics, sociology, physics, humanities, empirical science, visual arts and more to 11th and 12th graders (2nd and 3rd graders of high school in Korea).

Korea's first public international school

KIS, Korea's first public international school, was constructed by Jejudo Office of Education and opened in September in 2011, which YBM Co., Ltd. participates in its operation. Obtaining authorization from WASC and the USA school rating agency, it follows the USA school system and curriculum.

Healthcare Town

Healthcare Town, a medical tourism complex in Jeju, is designed to meet the increasing demand for good health and emotional healing. Healing Hills, the healthcare town offering specialized global medical services with the stunning natural background of the beautiful Jeju, is promoting the development of Korea's medical industry and tourism.

Healthcare Town, new engine for growth

The medical tourism market in Asia is undergoing fierce competition. In response to this trend, the Korean government designated medical tourism as one of 17 new growth engines in 2008, leading JDC to launch the Healthcare Town project in the same year. The infrastructure of the facility was completed in September 2016, and the growing sophistication of the island's medical tourism infrastructure is currently well under way.

Healthcare Town will not only meet the rising demand for premium medical services, but also serve as a hub of medical tourism by holding various events that can promote the healthcare industry, including seminars and conferences.

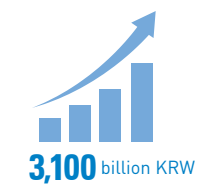

Myths and History Theme Park

Many villages, valleys, peaks, and the coastline of Jeju have their own, unique myths or legends. By leveraging this cultural and historical heritage, including stories of more than 18,000 gods, JDC is developing the Myths and History Theme Park.

Tourist Complex with Myths from the East and West

Myths and History Theme Park, which is scheduled to be opened in 2021 located at Andeok-myeon, Seogwipo-si (3,9865,601m² or approx. 1,210,000 pyeong), features myths, legends, and history of Jeju, as well as Asia and Europe.

District A, R, and H, invested by Landing Jeju Development, will be developed into a world-class resort (Jeju Shinhwa World) housing a theme park, hotel, and MICE facilities. In particular, District J, designed directly by JDC, will become a cultural park under the theme of Jeju's ancient myths and legends, offering various experiential programs, so that the tourists and residents can enjoy the unique culture of Jeju in a whole new, exciting way.

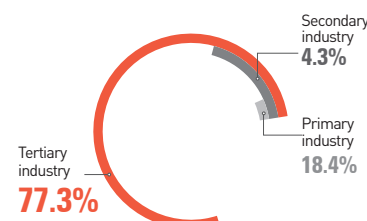

Investment and Business Benefits

Based on the Special Act of Jeju Free International City, Jeju is operating a system unique from other local governments. It not only provides tax reduction and financial support for domestic and foreign companies' stable settlement in Jeju but also all kinds of investment benefits for businesses.



Reinforcement of foreign investment zones & investment companies

- Provide administrative, financial support, and convenient service for foreign investments
- Sort foreign investment areas as complex and separated types, to provide all kinds of tax favors and system-related supports
- 100% exemption of local taxes in foreign investment areas for 15 years
- Set up a special housing supply system for houseless foreign residents within the limit of 10% of private housing
- Apply special cases on foreign investment companies' hiring oaged or nationally merited employees
- Companies hiring aged or nationally merited employees can receive employment subsidy of 1 million won per one employee (up to six months)

Benefits for investment promotion districts

- The only place in Korea where tax reduction or/and exemptionare allowed for both Koreans and foreigners
- Grant all kinds of tax favors and supply special cases regarding national and public property
- Grant case-by-case supporting benefits for nurturing core industries of Jeju

Benefits for ship registration special district

Ships whose port of registration is in Jeju or certain foreign ships are qualified for exemption of acquisition tax, property tax, common facilities tax, local education tax, farming and fishing villages' special tax, with the exception of registration tax

Improve foreigner immigration control system

- Allow 180 countries to travel or via Jeju without visa
- Extend the stay of professionals related to the development of Jeju Free International City for up to five years (able to re-extend)

Simplify procedures related to various regulation licensing when conducting development project

If someone who intends to carry out a development project wishes to obtain an approval for it, he or she is regarded as having obtained the permission, authorization, approval, negotiation and declaration of the relevant laws including Grassland Act and Mountainous District Management Act, to simplify the development procedure.

Support metropolitan companies in relocating to rural regions

- Grant reduction or/and exemption of taxes including national taxes(corporate tax, income tax) and local taxes(acquisition tax, registration tax, property tax)
- Financial support in compliance with the Special Act on Balanced National Development
- Financial support for business start-ups and competitiveness reinforcement

Improvement in medical conditions for globalization (Special Act benefited from Jeju Law and Jeju Health Care)

- Allow establishment of foreign medical institution
- Allow possessors of medical and pharmacist licenses to work for medical institutions or pharmacies built by foreigners
- Allow the promotional acts of foreign medical institutions intended to attract patients
